


WORLD POSTAL DAY:

HUMAN RIGHTS DAY AND CHRISTMAS CELEBRATION



During her speech she gave an insight on how to tackle during this unprecedented pandemic situation and how to keep calm in this tech world.




Ms. Janaki Sabesh




Platosen Samarasam
